

Pathways to Graduation 4+1 Option



Students who entered grade nine in September 2011 and thereafter or who are who were eligible to graduate in June 2015 or thereafter, have the following options available in order to meet the assessment requirements leading to a Regents or Local diploma: Pass four (4) required Regents examinations or Department Approved Alternatives as follows: ELA Regents exam, 1 math Regents exam, 1 science Regents exam, 1 social studies Regents exam Plus any one (1) of the following options:

- Complete all the requirements for the CDOS Commencement Credential found here <http://www.p12.nysed.gov/specialed/publications/2016-memos/cdosgraduation-pathway-option.html>; or
- Pass an additional math Regents exam in a different course or Department Approved Alternative; or
- Pass an additional science Regents exam in a different course or Department Approved Alternative; or · Pass an additional social studies Regents exam in a different course or Department Approved Alternative; or
- Pass an additional English assessment in a different course selected from the Department Approved Alternative list; or
- **Pass a Department approved CTE pathway assessment, following successful completion of an approved CTE program; or**
- Pass a Department approved pathway assessment in the Arts; or · Pass a Department approved pathway assessment in a Language other than English (LOTE)
