



## OUTSTANDING NEW TEACHER AWARD

The award recognizes exemplary efforts of new business educators early in their careers. Candidates will have demonstrated:

1. Excellence in the classroom
2. Creative and innovative approaches

Individuals must have made significant contributions to Business Education through some combination of program development, professional association activities, and community involvement.

### Who can nominate a Business Educator?

- Building Administrators
- Business Department Director/Coordinator/Chairpersons/Lead Teachers/Liaisons
- LIBTA Members

**\*\*All nominations must come from a teacher/dean/administrator who works in your district\*\***

### Nomination Qualifications:

Any business educator who is a member of LIBTA for the current school year is eligible. The nominee must be currently employed as a full-time business educator and must have taught in a business education program for a minimum of one, but not more than five years.

### Application Procedure:

1. Write a letter nominating a business educator. Include any factors which you feel are relevant including, but not limited to, classroom excellence you may have observed, extracurricular involvement, professional activities, devotion to students and/or education, overall attitude, etc. Your nomination is sufficient; however, if you wish to include additional recommendations, please limit them to no more than three recommendations.
2. Letters must be **postmarked by the last business day in March**. Please send to:
